

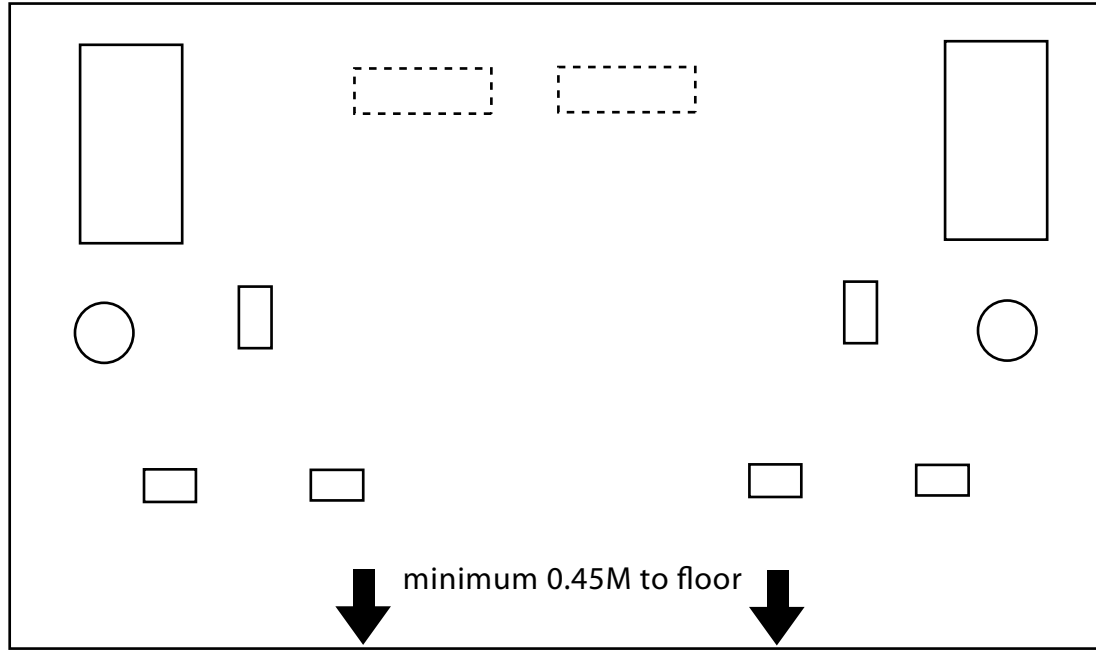
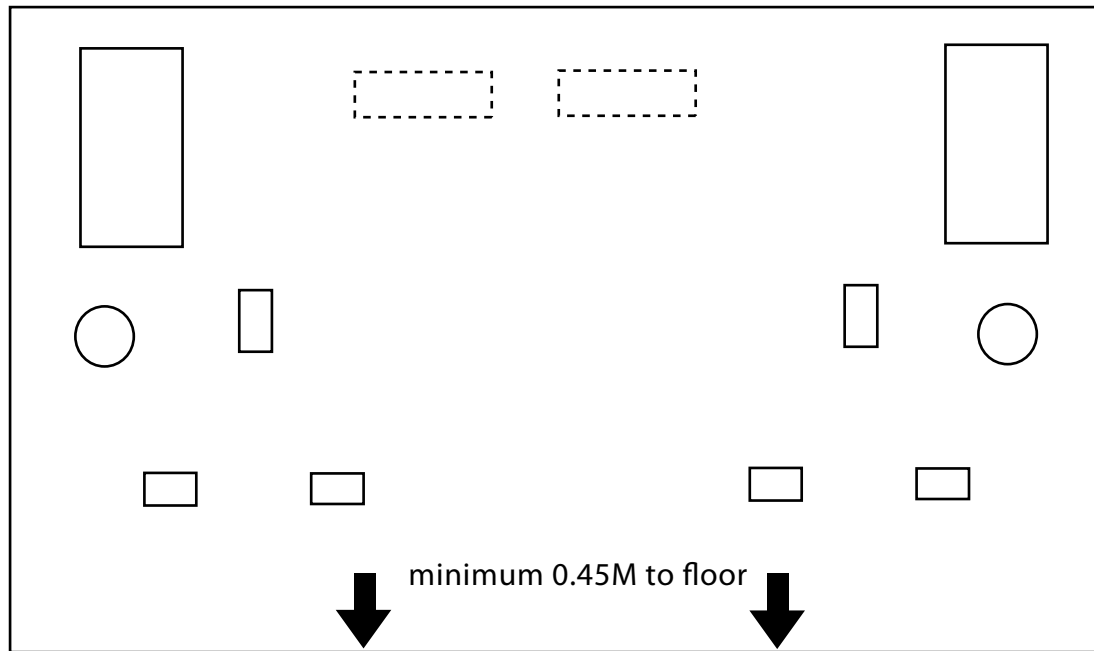
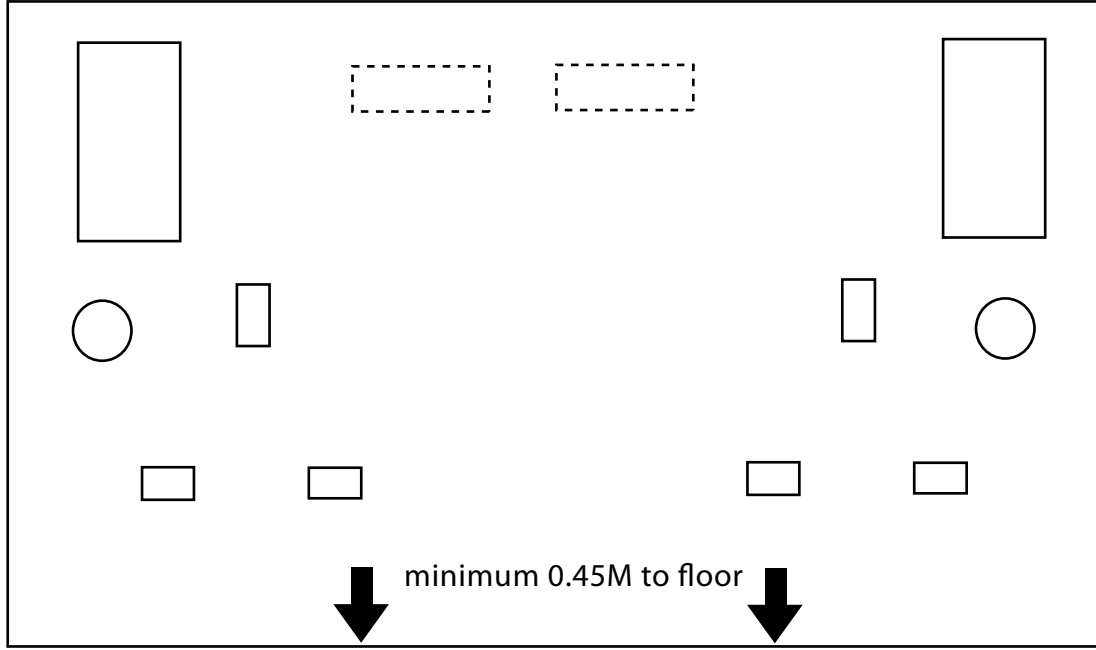
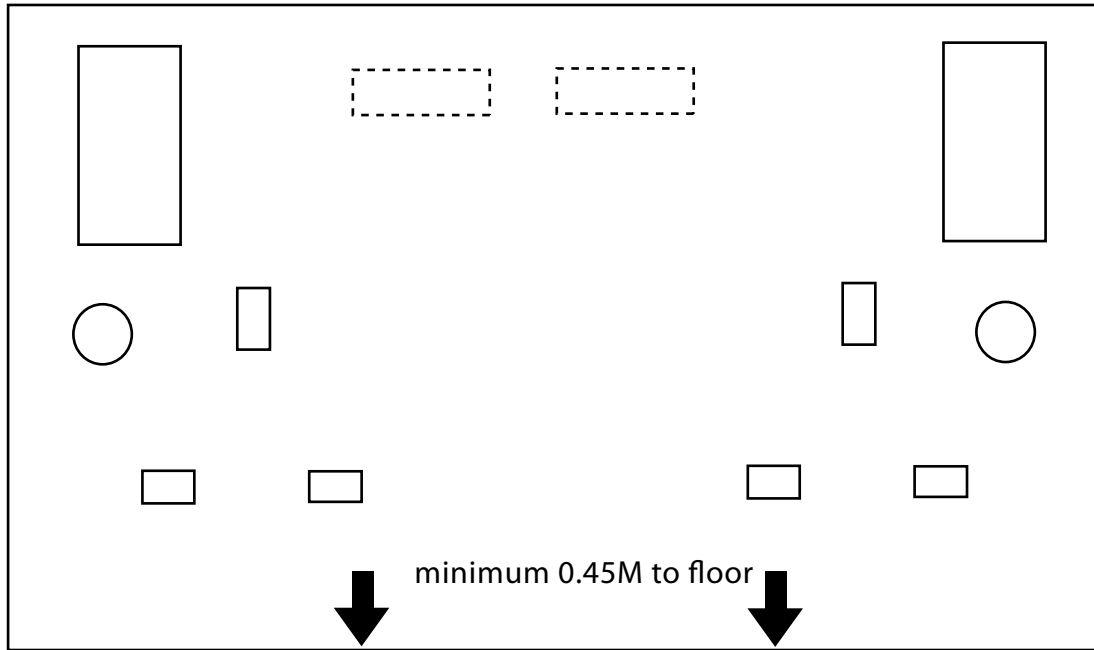
Outlet markers

Stick these markers on your walls with blutac, so that you can try out different layouts and check that the system will work for you. You could also leave them on the walls so the electrician knows where you want things. Details can be added *such as if you are having multi banked down lights you can say which ones belong to each bank.*

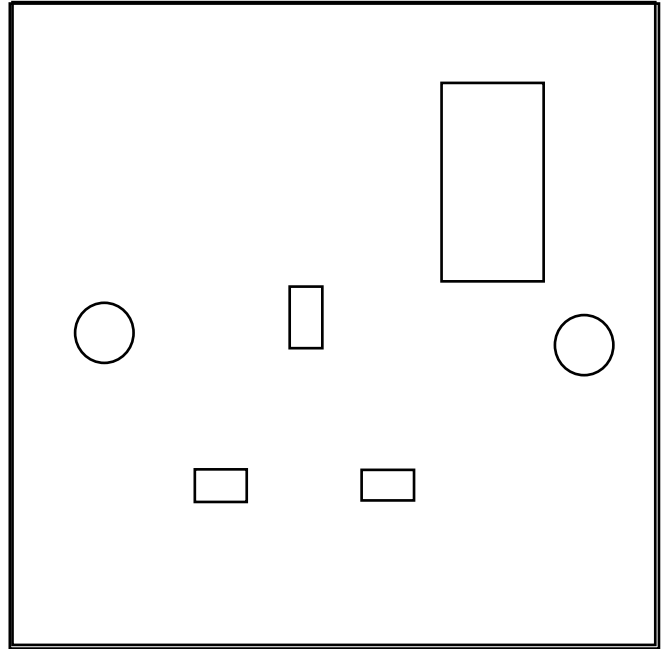
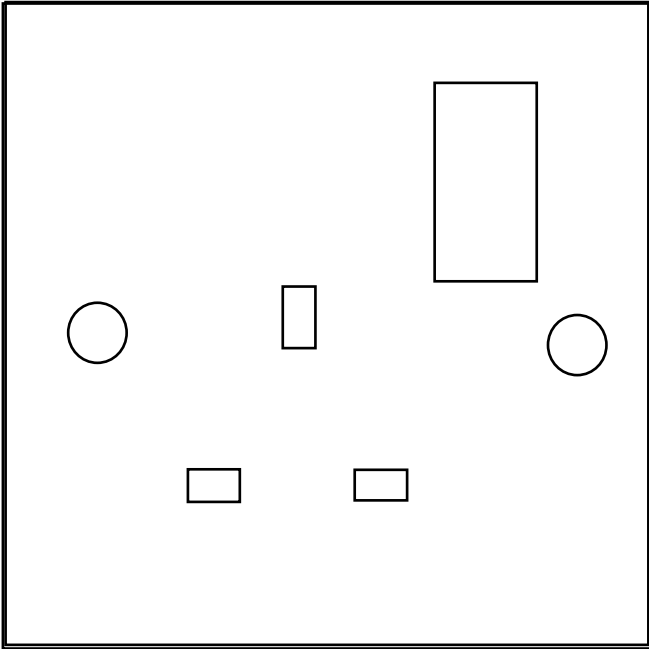
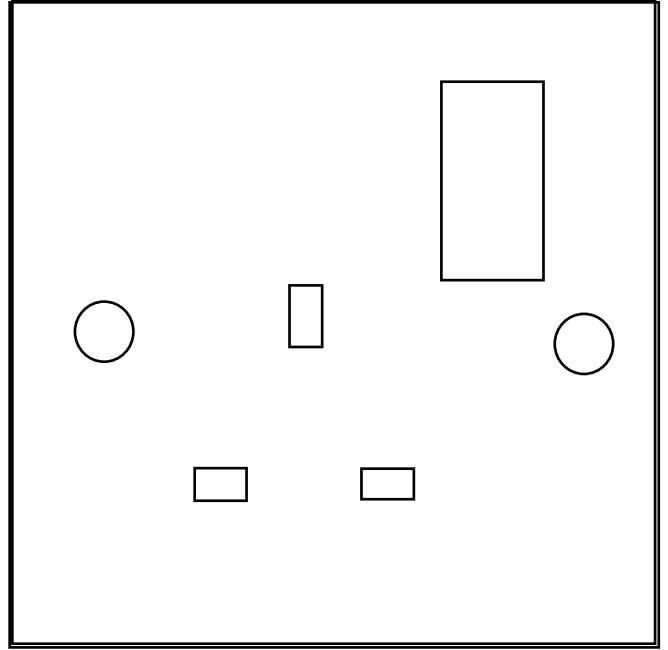
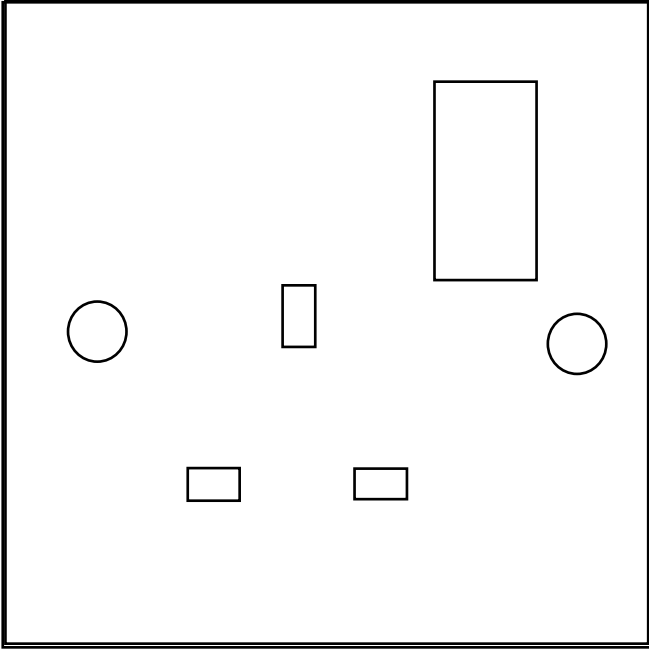
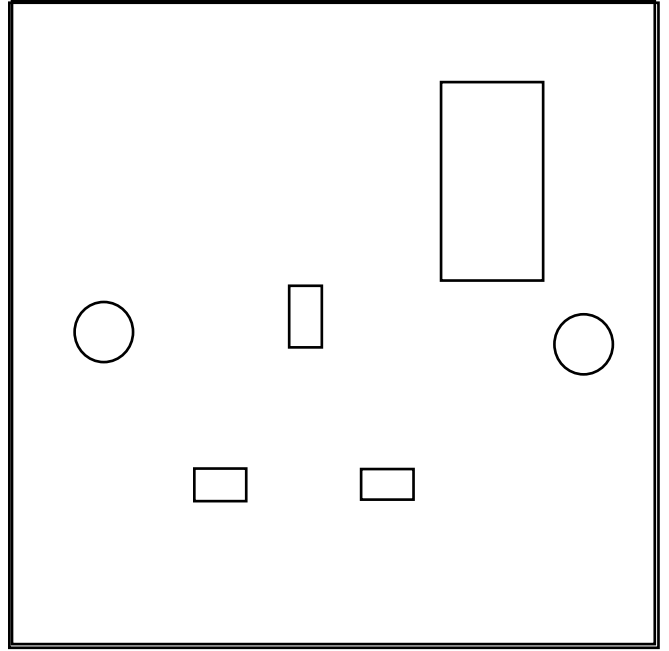
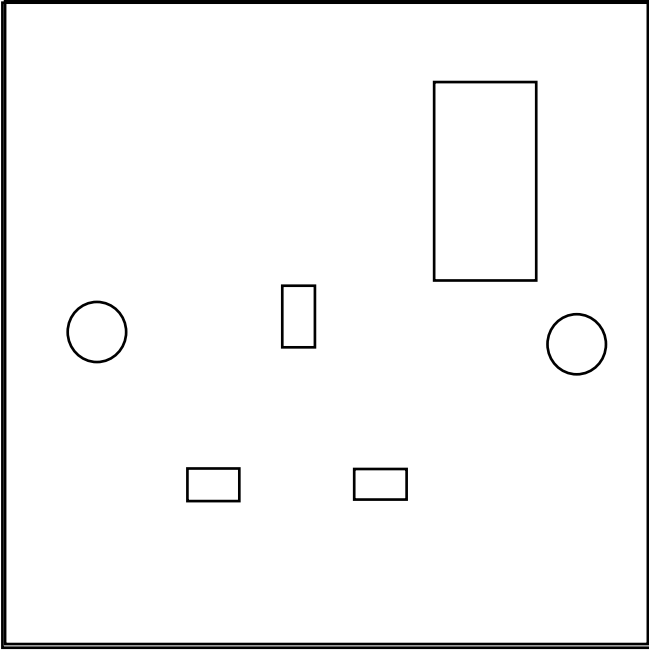
Fused outlets are used to control fixed items such as washing machines etc. and are set at an accessible point such as above the worktop with the cable outlet behind the machine.

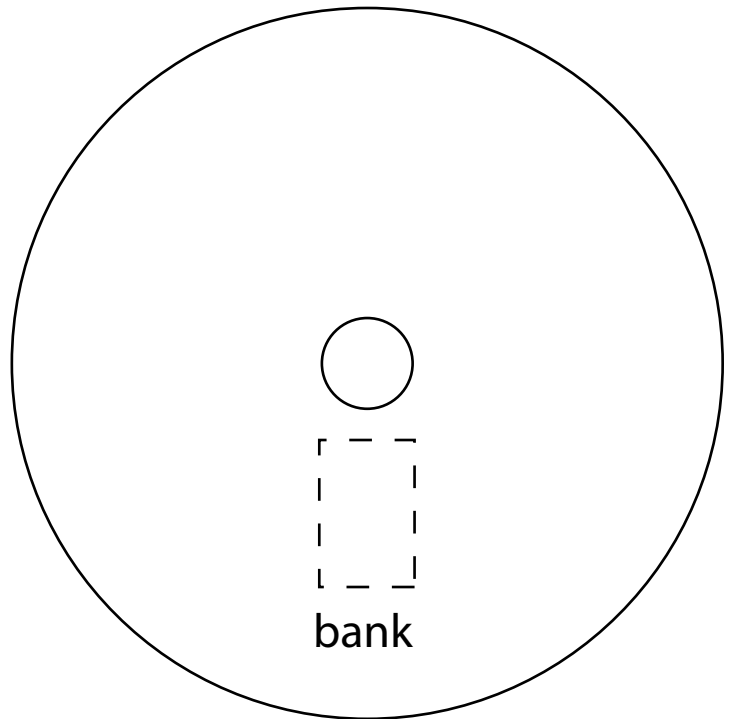
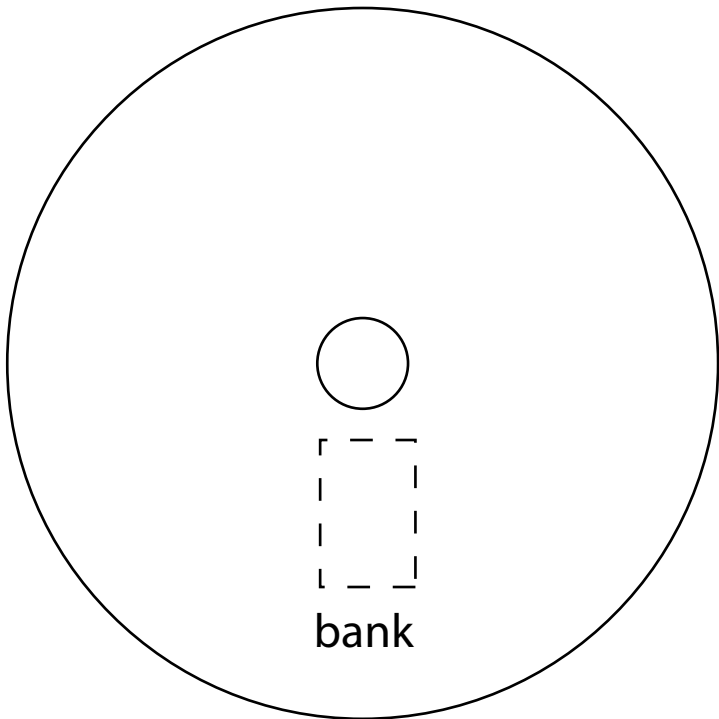
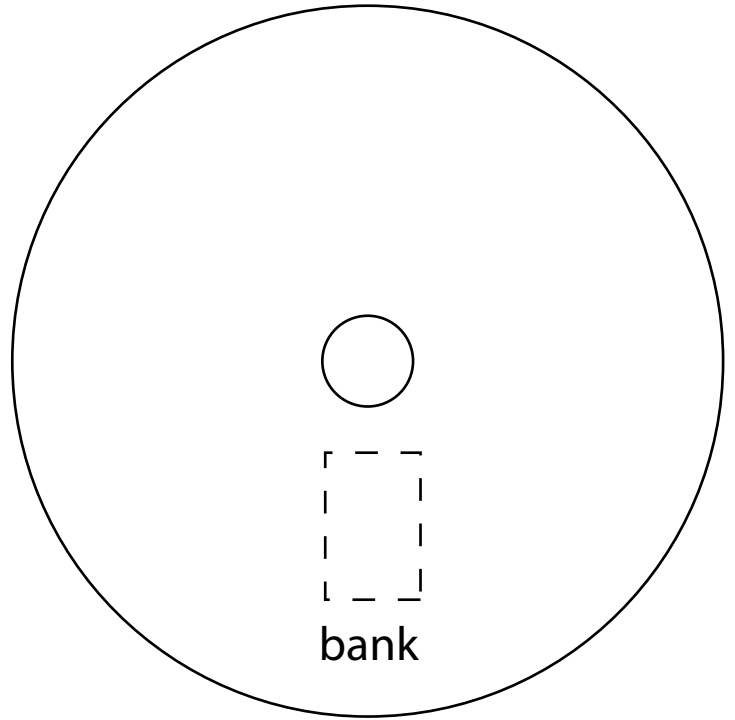
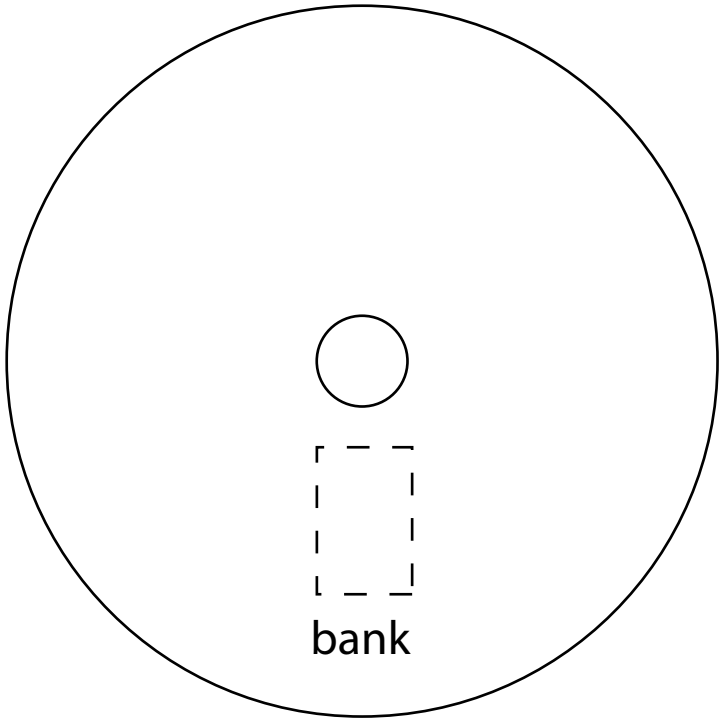
light switches
